From the Desk of Our Pastor

Corpus Christi



Many people in our culture need a clear idea of what biblical worship is all about. Intuitively we look for something that “we can get out of it,” usually a subjective feeling, some practical advice on how to live, or some insight to enhance our spiritual understanding when we come to church. We need to retrain ourselves to be truly biblical in our worship.

Simply put, worship is sacrifice. When the ancient Hebrews came before God, they brought a costly animal for sacrifice, not to mention a generous tithe. It was understood that the worshiper was a sinner, and the death of this animal was “vicarious,” that is, dying in his or her place. The consecrated meat was considered “most holy” and was “consumed” by God in the sacred fire, by the priests, and in the Peace Offering, by the people. This act of worship, therefore, was consummated by a communal meal binding God and the worshippers through the action of the priests.

Jesus is the fulfillment of the whole sacrificial system of the old covenant. As such, it is not just the sacrifice of His life on the cross that is important, but also the ensuing meal that is essentially linked to that Sacrifice. This is why John chapter 6 is so graphic in insisting that we must eat the very flesh of Jesus and drink His Blood. It takes work to believe this because it defies our senses. Just as the Father declared Jesus His divine Son at His baptism and the Transfiguration, so Jesus declared the Eucharist to be His very own body and blood; both must be embraced by faith, and both are inseparable.

We celebrate this Sunday The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ as a special moment in our liturgical year to ponder this core truth. Worship is an objective act by which we are transported at the altar to the original Sacrifice of Jesus, receive this sacrifice in a communal meal, and in turn, offer ourselves sacrificially to God and to one another. Yes, it does and should involve our emotions and subjective feeling, but it is an objective communal act of the corporate will.

I came out of a religious culture swamped, like the culture at large, with subjectivity or feeling-based sense of meaning. Training myself to understand and embrace true worship took a long time. Corpus Christi is a great time to reassess what is happening at Mass.

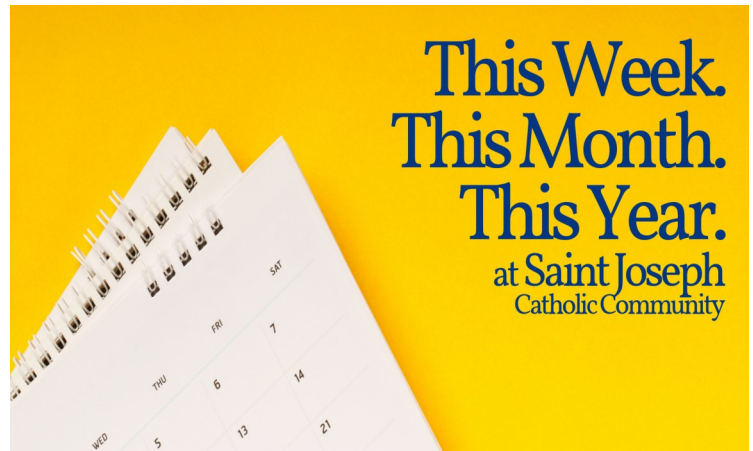
