




From the Desk of Our Pastor

In Gratitude

Pedro Silva, our Pastoral Associate for Adult Formation and Evangelization, is no longer working at SJCC. On behalf of so many of you whose lives have been transformed, I want to thank Pedro for his time with us.

As I remember, the first thing Pedro did was to carefully study Archbishop Lori's pastoral document, *A Light Brightly Visible II* that outlined his vision for formation and evangelization in our archdiocese. Pedro read and began to implement it immediately and enthusiastically, for this was exactly his philosophy of doing ministry. What did this look like for us?



First, we must dive into the hard and intense work of making disciples. The goal, in Pedro's words, is "to heal the whole person to get them to heaven". To do this, we need to give God space to work, because "we don't convert souls - that's God's job". God converts us through prayer. Pedro modeled for us a vibrant prayer life because "prayer is the foundation of our work".

Pedro had the gift of discerning where people were and leading them from there into spiritual maturity. This comes from listening: we must "listen people into existence." Moreover, we must reach out. "Christ didn't wait for the woman at the well; He went to her. Relational ministry answers the call of Pope Francis to go out into the peripheries of our community, meaning, we don't sit in our offices and wait for people -- we allow the Spirit to lead us to them."

Another essential trait of formation and evangelization is hospitality. "By cooking a homemade meal, decorating a room beautifully, and by welcoming, we can show the individual that they are loved and encounter God's grace." Along with hospitality is intentionality. "God calls us by name, so we should remember people's names and stories. This mirrors our Master's own way of recalling the past in order to redeem it in the present."

Finally, "discipleship ends in friendship. How can one disciple another and not end as friends? Did Jesus not disciple the disciples for 3 years and, at the end, proclaim that they were his friends? Only friends can truly exemplify St. John's call to love."

In two short years Pedro has left his fingerprints on our congregation. We intend to build upon this foundation that Pedro has built. He has made disciples among us who will carry on his work.
