

## From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

#### Update on our Structural Repairs in the Sanctuary

Someone asked this week where we are with our construction project and so I thought it would be a good idea to give you all an update. First, the good news of your charitable response to the 2-year pledge campaign is helping to fund this inherited and unanticipated burden placed upon us.

As you know, the north side was reconstructed last fall. It was completed at the cost of \$380,000. We thank God that the problem was detected before a much more serious problem occurred.



This summer we saw the construction site tented over with protective plastic on the south side, covering the 4 columns in the corner. Of these 4 columns, only the first in the very corner was unscathed from water damage. Because of the many steps it takes to repair the columns we anticipate the repairs running into late fall, as each step is engineered according to the extent of damage, which is extensive. So far, we have been able to remain in the church for services and will do everything possible to keep it that way.

Recently, we were able to explore the 4 remaining columns on the south side once the three front columns were sufficiently reinforced. Unfortunately, the news is not good as we discovered that three of them will need reinforcement as well. The two columns closest to the chapel required the removal of cabinets and walls to be able to access the damage and be able to repair them. The reality is that the cost of these south side structural repairs could reach and exceed \$500,000.

Again, this letter is meant only to give you all an update. On the bright side, we are securing a solid foundation for our sanctuary for the future. We hope that as we do this, we are also building a solid foundation in our corporate spiritual life as well for the present and future.


