



From the Desk of Our Associate Pastor

Speaking the Truth with Love

We have often heard that we must speak the truth with love. Personally, I find this very hard to do, and do not see it happen much around me. Our Scriptures for this weekend bring it all into sharp focus for us.

Right off the bat God smacks His Prophet Ezekiel in the face with a terrible responsibility. As a "watchman" he must warn the people of their sin. If he fails to do this, both he and his people will die with their guilt and he will be responsible for their death! If he does warn them and they do not repent, then their sin is on their own head, and he keeps his.



Transferred to our situation at SJCC, We, especially I as your pastor, are under the obligation to speak the truth to one another, and the stakes could not be higher.

In our Gospel Jesus clearly lays out for us what we must do when someone sins against us. We must be direct and speak the truth. If that person doesn't listen, bring a neutral 3rd party into the situation. If that doesn't work, bring it to the Church, and if that person still persists in sin and doesn't reconcile, then that person is to be treated as one who is not a believer, an outcast.

Of course, all this must be done with love, as St. Paul tells us in our Epistle reading. There must be a genuine desire for offenders to see their sin, repent, and be reconciled. It astounds me that I hardly ever see this happen. Usually, the offended person doesn't possess the love and courage to be direct. Rather, he or she goes to a third party and talk s the other down, de facto making the offender an outcast without due process. This is evil, and it occurs in our homes, places of employment, schools, everywhere.

There is such a thing as truth. We must be bold to speak it both as a church and as individuals. There is such a thing as love, which is modeled by Jesus Himself. Love manifests itself in reaching out, in self-sacrifice. The two must come together in us. One way for this to happen is our seminar "Bearing the Beams of Love" where we will learn to be both direct with truth and compassionate in our love.



A columbarium witnesses our faith in the resurrection and life everlasting. It is a resting place for the cremated remains of those who loved the Church. It reminds us of how the church ministers to the spiritual needs of its members, from baptism through death into eternal life.

A columbarium supports and nurtures the Corporal Works of Mercy through appropriate interment, respect, reverence, dignity, and hope of the Resurrection.



A newly constructed columbarium will reside on sacred grounds of the Historic Sykesville Church in Downtown Sykesville. It is a granite structure installed on a concrete patio surrounded by stone walls and landscaping.

Our columbarium has six sides consisting of three tiers, each housing twenty-four niches for a total of seventy-two. Each niche is 11" x 11" x 11" and holds a maximum of two urns and includes a customizable solid bronze plaque.

The chart below shows the niche prices by tier, including the cost of perpetual care and the bronze plaque.

Columbarium Price List

Niche + Perpetual Care + Bronze Plaque

Sunrise (top rows 1 & 2) \$2,550 + \$510 + \$895 = \$3,955

Heart (middle rows 3 & 4) \$2,400 + \$480 + \$895 = \$3,775

Soul (lower rows 5 & 6) \$2,100 + \$ 420 + \$895 = \$3,415

Each solid bronze memorial includes space for up to two names, dates, and one personalized line of text of your choosing. The final death date is included and will be ordered upon the death of the individual(s).

Additional fees apply for the opening and closing of the niche for each interment, which range from \$100 - \$300.
