

From the Desk of Our Pastor

Preparing for the Feast

This life of ours is a preparation for the great feast of God, the marriage supper of the Lamb, which we will experience beyond this present life. The prophet Isaiah describes it in our reading for this Sunday as a feast with the richest food and finest wine. Heaven is a feast, and with our new bodies we will not have to worry about cholesterol, acid reflux, and the bloated feeling of eating too much. But it will take a lot of preparation to get there; we cannot just show up at the door, so to speak. There are certain things that must happen.



First, we need to embrace God's remedy for sin and death. Isaiah speaks of God "swallowing up" the veils of all people, and "swallowing up" death itself. Our translations often do not catch this idea of "swallowing up" but translate the word "destroy" instead. In fact, death was likened to a monster that swallows all of us mortals up. In this prophecy, God promises to reverse this ugly inevitability, where He will swallow up the swallower. The veil is the death shroud. The Shroud of Turin is the visible fulfillment of this prophecy. The feast is only for immortals who are made so through faith in Christ.

Second, we must learn the "secret" which St. Paul teaches us in Philippians. It is to be indifferent to our temporal circumstances, whatever they may be. Our circumstances mean absolutely nothing; good circumstances cannot make us truly happy, and undesirable circumstances, if we are in Christ, cannot bring us down. Why? Because we walk as immortals in this temporal world with our eyes of faith locked on to the great feast before us.

Finally, we must accept God's invitation to the feast and be dressed accordingly. The shocking things in our parable for this week are 1) people will not take the king's invitation, because they are too involved in temporal matters, and 2) the king in the parable throws the poor soul who did not dress appropriately into outer darkness. As at the fall, when our first parents covered their nakedness with leaves, clothing ourselves in our own righteousness is insufficient to stand before our King Jesus. Salvation is described as receiving a white robe, which we receive by grace at our baptism, and which we keep spotless by grace throughout a faithful life. What a feast it will be for us all to sit around the Lord's table together, which our Eucharist is a foretaste.




