## From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

### **It's OK to Be Sad Sometimes**

We hear the Apostle say, "Rejoice in the Lord Always, again, I say rejoice." The joy He speaks of is a profound joy that settles in the depths of our hearts and penetrates all of our emotions, even the emotion of sadness. Yes, it is possible to be sad on one level of our being, but joyful on an even deeper level. Everything turns on what we are sad about. If we are sad about the right things, our sadness will eventually dissolve into joy.



Consider Isaiah's dialogue with God in our reading this week. It is touched with a beautiful melancholy that should move our hard hearts. It begins and ends with the reference to God as father; a highly unusual way to address God in the Old Testament. This places the soul in a humble but hopeful posture before God. Isaiah then asks hard questions; why do you let us wander from you? Why harden our hearts so we do not fear you? In other words, you can do something about our sinful state, so why not do it?

Out of sheer longing, he asks God to rend the heavens and come down and show Himself, shaking this earth of ours, getting our attention. God can be angry with us, not only because we are sinful, but especially because no one calls out to God for help; we cannot even rouse ourselves to repent! Therefore, God has "hidden himself" and we, who are but clay, are lost in our guilt.

In the middle of all this is a surge of hope, a promise seemingly out of place. "No ear has ever heard, or eye seen any God but you are doing such deeds for those who wait for Him." If we can connect with this promise by faith, feel the sadness of our condition, and express remorse for our hapless condition, we will find ourselves humbly waiting for God and His salvation. This is the spirit of Advent.

I think a little sadness would do us good this Advent if it leads us to repentance. Sadness and longing bring us to a reflective state of mind and soul and soften our hearts which have become so hardened that we cannot even comprehend our sins. This, I think, is what Jesus is warning us about in the Gospel; be watchful and wait for Jesus. An excellent opportunity to do this is Friday evening from 5:30 to 7:30. Please come and join us!
