From the Desk of Our Pastor

Our Wonderful Staff, Letter Four

Last but not least, I want to present to you our Liturgical staff. It is very small, consisting of Steve Cox, our Director of Liturgy and Music, and his assistant, Andrew Nellies. Steve, like me, is a relatively new "convert" to the Catholic Church, entering one year before me (2011). He is blessed to have a wonderfully rich ecclesial heritage, the son of a highly respected and well-known Anglican priest in Catonsville. He grew up heavily involved in the church's life, especially in music. At UMBC, he brought together his two loves of music and religious studies. Already, he was feeling the tug toward Catholicism, which led him to do a Masters in Theology at the Dominican House in Washington.



With this background, Steve has a wonderful theological grasp of the Mass, its liturgy, and its music. Since his father's church was evangelical in spirit, Steve is comfortable with contemporary praise songs, as well as music in the Anglican and Catholic traditions. Steve intuitively understands my aspirations for worship as Pastor of SJCC. We both know that the transition has not been easy from the music and liturgy we were accustomed to before. Though Steve and I have Anglican backgrounds, we have no mandate or intention to make SJCC "Anglican" or impose on it the liturgy of the Ordinariate of the Chair of St. Peter, of which both Fr. Patrick and I are priests. In fact, Steve has a lot of experience with music in the Catholic Church as well, having served in the music program of an Archdiocesan parish in Baltimore City for seven years before he arrived at Saint Joseph. We desire to choose the best music of the ages that conforms best to the meaning of the Mass, whether it be Catholic or from other traditions such as Anglican, Lutheran, or contemporary. (Fr. Patrick and I will give a homily series on the Mass, explaining it from the beginning to the end this Lent.)

We are very happy to have Andrew Nellies on board to assist Steve both administratively as well as musically. Andrew is a man of many talents and has shown himself useful in so many ways. What makes him so special is his genuine devotion to Jesus, his vibrant faith, and his love for liturgy. Andrew belongs to the large and wonderful Nellies family of our church and is engaged to marry his beautiful fiancée Monica this spring.

Please feel free to engage these two men after Mass and ask them questions about the music and get to know them. We know that we cannot satisfy everyone all the time, so please encourage them, for theirs is not an easy task.

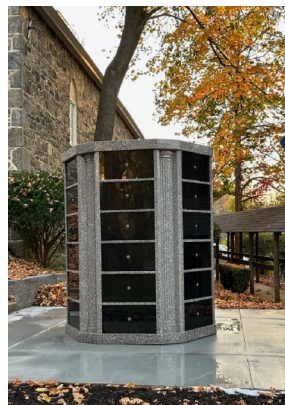
