## From the Desk of Our Associate Pastor ....

Dear faithful,

Last Monday we heard of our Lord's baptism as told by Mark's Gospel. Today we hear what happened next as told by the Gospel of John. We're at the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Crowds have gone down to the Jordan valley to hear John the Baptist. John sees Jesus walking by and points Him out to two of his disciples: "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two men follow. I imagine them doing so cautiously, wanting not to be observed. But Jesus turns, sees them, and speaks His first words in the John's Gospel:



"What are you looking for?" In other words: What are you seeking? What are you after?

These are not just His first words in the Gospel. They're the first words Jesus has spoken to us from Christmas on. In the Gospels of Christmas, He was silent; He had just been born after all! The same for the feast of Mary, Mother of God: no word from Him. Nothing on the Epiphany; nothing on the Feast of His Baptism. Today, though, Christ turns and sees us following—and He speaks. He asks us: What are you seeking?

In the first reading, Samuel hears a voice in the night, three times. Eli eventually realizes what's going on and tells the boy how to answer if the voice comes again. And it does, for a fourth time. But, when it does, it's more than a voice. This time it says, "the Lord came and revealed his presence." Not just a disconnected voice, but a Presence.

Back to the Jordan. The two disciples had been listening for some time to a voice: John the Baptist. That's how John described himself. Now suddenly the Lord Himself has come in the flesh, speaking to them—not disconnected at all. And so with us: The Lord is present among us. "What do you want?" In response, the disciples ask, "Where are you staying?" Jesus responds: "Come, and you will see."

Come, and see. Jesus invites them—and us—to share His future and see the signs He will work: changing water into wine, giving sight to the blind, raising the dead. Come, and see Me lifted up on the Cross and risen from the dead. Come, and see that I live with the Father and He with Me, and I want you to live there too. Jesus invites us to "come and see" Him in the coming feasts and seasons wherein we unfold His mysteries. He's asking us to walk with Him this year, and see the glory of the Father shining in Him.
