

## From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

## The Mass: Liturgy of the Word

We already know what "liturgy" means; it is from a Greek word found in the Bible, a word used for worshipping together (Acts 13:2), specifically, the work or service of the people. This idea comes right out of the Old Testament where the word "work" is used for the Temple service. Our "Liturgy of the Word," the first part of our Mass, was handed to us directly from the Jewish Synagogue, while the second part, "Eucharist," is a sacrifice directly linked to the Temple service.



When we come to worship, we come to work. We engage our hearts and minds with Holy Scripture and the responses. The first reading is from the Old Testament because the origins of all we believe as Christians are found there. Christ is hidden in the Old, and revealed in the New. The Psalm is sung with responses; it is the prayer book of the ancient Hebrews and Jews, but more importantly, the Psalter is the prayer book of the Messiah, Jesus, and, therefore, His Church. Then comes the Epistle reading and the Gospel, which the Clergy always read.

The homily, if presented as Mother Church intends it, is the word of Christ through the priest or deacon, inspired by the Scriptural readings, to "open up the meaning" of the text to the congregation and inspire all in faith, hope, and love, but also to obedience. It must not be a personal "opinion," but a word "hot" from the Holy Spirit, speaking with authority like Jesus preached. Because men can be fallible, the Creed is said in unison right after the homily to rectify anything amiss in the homily.

The Liturgy of the Word ends with the Prayers of the Faithful and the people's response after each prayer. Everything in the Liturgy of the Word demands our active engagement of mind and heart: Jesus warns, "Let those who have ears to hear let him hear." The responses show our affirmation of the truth heard.

The Apostle Paul desires that the Word of God dwell in us richly. We Catholics are no strangers to the Word of God because it is embedded in our Liturgy. However, we can do much more by reading Scripture independently during the week from the daily Mass readings and prayerfully meditating on the coming Sunday readings in preparation. What a treasure we have in sacred Scriptures!






