

Exiting the Presence of the Great King

The Holy Feast is over. Jesus, our host has set the table at the beginning through His priest and/or deacon, and He is humble to wash the dishes at the end. For the faithful, it is a time of humble reflection of the Humility of God who has offered Himself to us in such a magnificent way. Nothing is hurried in the presence of the Great King.





this prayer differs according to the day. Announcements are then given. Finally, for the fourth time in the Mass the covenantal words "The Lord be with you" are offered, and the congregation responds, "and with your spirit." Then the final blessing is given. The blessing is crucial. In the Bible blessings were not mere well-wishing but were given with power. Only when God blessed His creatures at creation were they empowered to function and succeed in that for which they were made. Likewise, we are empowered to be "fruitful and multiply" in our daily activities in union with Jesus by this sacrament.

The priest or deacon will give the dismissal to the congregation that directs them into the world. In fact, the word "Mass" comes from the Latin word "to send." It is our privilege and responsibility, who are so graced by God, to change the world around us like Jesus did.

The Mass does not end until the recession hymn is finished and the Clergy bow in prayer to the Crucifix at the back. It is rude to dash out before this happens. What are we saying with our bodies when we exit Mass like we exit a movie theater? That we have done our religious obligation and now "I'm out of here?" I have more important things to do than hang out till the end? That the Great King is not present, and this is a mere ritual? Is nothing we have taught over the last few weeks real? No! We exit with reverence just like we would exit the presence of human dignitaries – when it is over. When we do exit, we do it with deep reverence, genuflecting with our bodies, and crossing ourselves with holy water, a reminder of our baptism. And, while you are at it, linger in the narthex a while, or out on the porch, and meet someone new. Then we will become a friendly church!
