

# From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

## Holy Triduum, Easter, 2024

In the face of political chaos, wars, and the general craziness that buzzes in the craniums of so many of us human beings, we get to experience the sanity of Holy Week. I want you to try to imagine this. For the first 40 years of my life I never experienced Holy Week. Hardly anything happened during the week, or nothing at all, until Easter Sunday, and the only thing that made this Sunday service different was singing, "Christ the Lord is Risen Today." I always felt like there must be something more, but didn't know what it was. Ever since I became Catholic, I'm no longer haunted with that feeling.



Indeed, I really didn't know exactly what the Triduum was until Fr. Neville corrected me when I was on staff. How do you explain something so magnificent, so moving, so full of pathos and the dark beauty of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil? As we tried to explain in our homily series on the Mass, what we are doing is not just "remembering" these events, but actually participating in these world-changing events just as truly as the Disciples did. This is a deep mystery how we all are transported into that moment in time. This mystery is meant to be experienced and embraced by our faith and sanctified imagination; we are there!

And we take this journey together. Together we are with Jesus in the upper room where He washes our feet and gives us the command to love one another as He has loved us. We are together with Him in the Garden, fighting off sleep like the Disciples in our prayers. We watch the horrifying scenes of Jesus' trial, beatings and finally His death. It is here, if we linger long enough underneath the cross, that we come to grips with our sins that placed Him there. Of all our challenges in life, the greatest of all is coming to terms with the fact that we are sinners, but that we are loved, and the remedy hangs before us with outstretched arms.

Finally, we are together as we experience the glory of the resurrection on Easter morning. With Mary Magdalen and Peter and John we are caught up with wonder and awe of the most time altering event in the history of the world, where a Strong Man broke the power of sin and death, leaving behind an empty tomb. Dear brothers and sisters, how does it get any better than this?

#### Administrative Assistant to Youth and Young Adult Ministry

This position is a part-time (12 hr./week), non-exempt, non-benefit position. 

Faith In Action Annual Appeal for Catholic Ministries SJCC Goal \$131,883 Giving to-date \$100,752 Percentage to Goal 76% Dear Friends in Christ,

I have great news! The work on reinforcing the deteriorated columns of our church (ten in all) is complete! Through your generous contributions to the Stained Glass and Structural Reinforcement Project we were able to fund a substantial portion of the \$1.2 million it cost. However, to wholly fund the cost, we had to withdraw the difference from our reserve funds.

Unfortunately, with the fiscal impact of the epidemic happening consecutively with the cost to secure the foundation of our church we were forced to delay replacing the deteriorating roofs of the church and office building for several years. Now we are faced with no option other than to replace these roofs to prevent further interior damage from these failing roof systems.

Starting in April we will begin an in-pew campaign through second collections for a period of one year; except for previously scheduled special and second collections. Please know that 100% of your donations for the roof replacement project will be used to fund the roof replacement project. It is our intention that our regular offertory giving remains strong, which is crucial to support our day-to -day operations.


