



# From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

# The Most Dangerous Thing in the World

When I think of dangers, my mind immediately goes to things like auto accidents, deadly diseases, violent criminals, and if in the wild, scary animals like venomous snakes. But there is something far more dangerous than any of these things or many other dangers we can think of. Sin is the most dangerous and deadly thing we humans will ever face.



I know that we are in the Easter season and have already left Lent far behind with all its emphasis on sin and

repentance. But when I see the readings for this coming Sunday, I see that we need to revisit the issue. First, in Peter's speech, he accuses his own people, the Jews, for making the most colossal mistake in history. They, the covenant people of God, put God to death by crucifying Jesus, the author of life, who was the fulfillment of all the covenantal promises. Why did they do this? It is surely not that they were the evilest people on earth. Rather, the covenant people of God, the Jews, represent all of humanity as a sort of mirror for all to see themselves as they truly are. The whole world crucified Jesus through the Jews and the Romans.

This human act is the focal point of all sins committed individually or corporately of the whole human race. As we read in the passion narrative a couple of weeks ago, we are all in the crowd crying, "crucify Him." Our sin makes us deadly, a venom coursing through our veins that is killing us and kills others we contaminate. Our sins are dangerous and make us more dangerous than anything we can think of.

The greatest sin of our generation is that it does not even acknowledge sin for what it is. We no longer make the crucial connection between sin and its consequence, death. We think death is some sort of evolutionary malfunction of nature. When we no longer see sin as our deadliest danger, we can no longer understand Jesus and His sacrifice. In our Epistle reading St. John warns us against sin, but if we slip into it, as we are prone to do, we have an Advocate, Jesus the Righteous One, who is our "expiation" for our sin. This big word can be understood as the "remedy," for which there is no other in all of creation.

Your biggest problem, biggest danger, is sin. If you are totally convinced of this, then to Jesus you will go! Easter is the season to rejoice in Jesus our salvation!
