## From the Desk of Our Pastor ....

### Holy Trinity, 2024

The term “God” is, in and of itself, a somewhat amorphous term that can mean many things to different people. People use it in so many ways without thinking what it means. In the end, God is often thought of as some vague reference point out “there” somewhere. What adds to the ambiguity is the utter transcendence of God above all creatures, words of expression, and human thought. How do we even begin to talk about God?



Easter and Pentecost give us our answer. Easter is all about experiencing the living, risen Christ, described as the Son of God and, by virtue of the incarnation, our “brother.” Pentecost is when the Holy Spirit comes upon us, revealing Christ to us and empowering us to live like Christ. What is critical to grasp here is that this new “knowledge” of God is not primarily intellectual but experiential.

Like the first apostles, we experience God as “Father” through Jesus Christ, His Son. The metaphors of “Father” and “Son” express the equality between the Father and the Son, but also a distinction, because the Father is not the Son, and the Son is not the Father, just as in human relationships. We can only know the Son as the Lord Yahweh through the work of the Holy Spirit, for “flesh and blood” can not reveal this mystery to our souls. The fundamental truth about God is that He is triune; we experience Him as our Father through our brother Jesus, who is revealed to us by the Holy Spirit. St. Paul draws the obvious conclusion of this experience in our Romans reading: our status and identity changed, and we are now joint heirs with Christ. We are made one with the Immortal God-Head.

Holy Trinity Sunday is not primarily about doctrine, which can never fully explain the mystery but provides us with language to describe to others what we have experienced. Today, even words like “having a relationship with God” do not resonate in our culture of broken and dissatisfying relationships. How can one get excited about “having a relationship” with God when many do not even know what a healthy and good relationship is? Even a word like “father” can be frightening. We can share our experience of our encounter with Jesus through which the Holy Spirit can work into the lives of others. Jesus can then introduce them to His Father and open up a whole new experience of a glorious family of divine relationships.

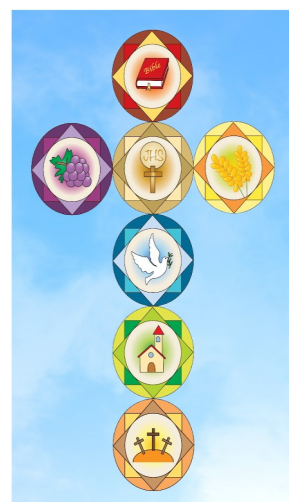
