From the Desk of Our Pastor

Our Catholic Duty



Our readings for this Sunday crystal clear what has become muddy and ambiguous in our culture at large, even among parishioners in our church. Jesus defines marriage as a union between a man and a woman, and the marital act both unitive (become one flesh), and productive (open to children). The Church's one foundation is Jesus Christ her Lord; if we believe anything else, we must honestly ask, "by what authority do I believe this?"

Moreover, the Church clearly teaches that contraceptives, which block the creative aspect of the marital act, fundamentally alters the psychology of both the man and the woman, and of the culture at large (see *Humanae Vitae*). Without these two crucial original reasons for sex, the unitive and openness to life, the act is no longer marital (even if married), but something else, something less than, and our humanity itself becomes something less than, something sexualized, persons reduced to objects of the other. What was always thought of as holy and special has become casual and cheap. **Contraception** is a huge problem in our church; we are so obsessed with freedom and control, that the church's teaching seems absurd and backward, never really taking Jesus and His Church's teaching seriously.

With this debasing our human dignity, it is easy to take the next step, and that is abortion. Contrary to natural law, that is, our innate knowledge of what is good and evil, dictated to us by our consciences **if** they are healthy, we kill our babies. Whether using contraceptives or abortion, that which is fully human, the baby developing in the womb, is considered a problem to be solved. Unborn babies are deceitfully and maliciously called "products of intercourse" in the medical community. Nothing contradicts objective scientific truth **more** than this. The seared conscience gives our culture leave to live in this deadly contradiction.

The so-called "Right to Reproductive Freedom" that we are to vote on this November is pure evil. It is our Catholic duty to vote against it. It is not only an assault against our unborn babies, but against the rights and dignity of our families. The state would be limiting young girls' options, corralling them into abortions without presenting alternatives, and limiting parents' power to speak into their children's lives. The state with its laws, in this case enshrining abortion in its constitution, creates deep wounds without the moral or spiritual power or authority to heal. Catholics, let us step back and take a look at all this madness, repent, and do the right thing.

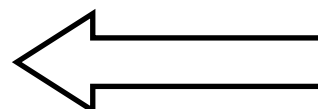

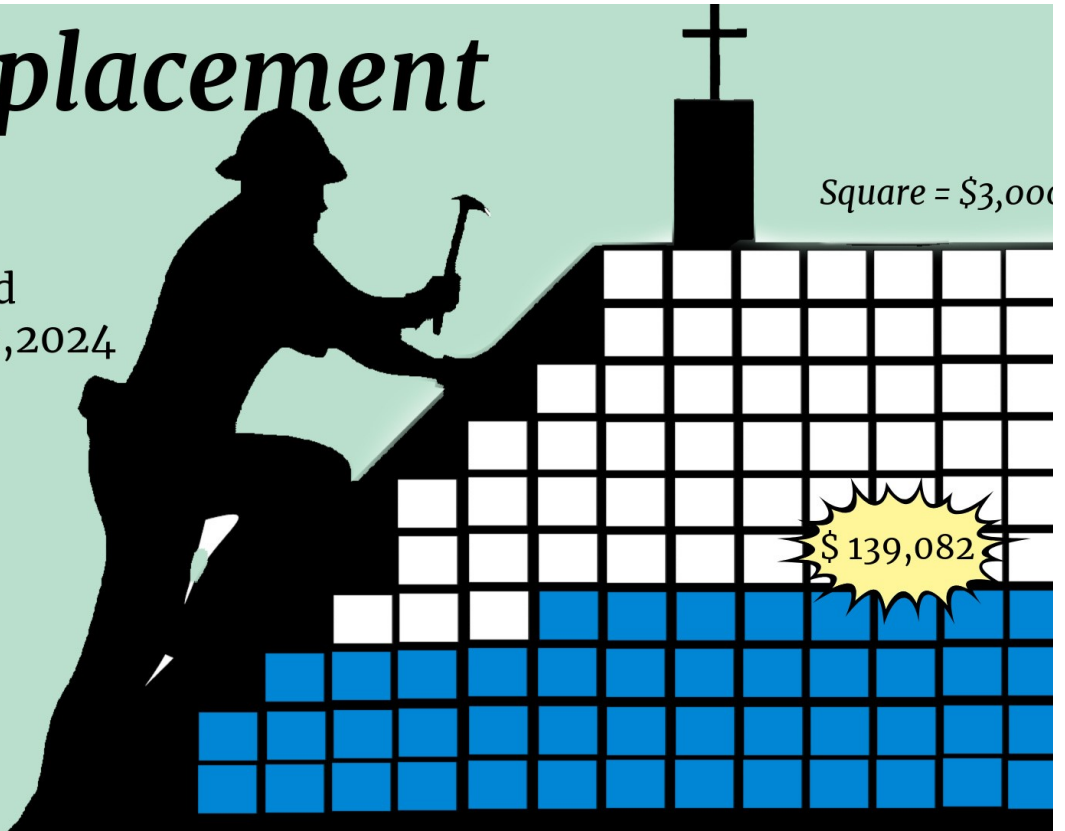

Annual Report, Fiscal Year 2023-2024

As I reflect on this last year, the words of Psalm 133 come to mind; “Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity.” Think about it. This is an election year, and our country and the world are in turmoil. But here at SJCC, there is a sense of peace, joy, and unity in Christ. There is also a growing sense of excitement; the Holy Spirit is at work among us, and what a privilege to move together in the Spirit of Christ to accomplish our mission of bringing everyone within the boundaries of our parish community into our church.

Our financial growth in the past year has been a testament to our stability. Offertory Collections increased 3% from the prior fiscal year. Although giving through envelopes decreased, this was more than offset by an increase in electronic giving via Faith Direct. Loose collections increased by almost \$10,000 over FY2023. We have noted a slight increase in our average weekly mass attendance.

Our other sources of income include interest on savings and investment accounts, charitable donations, specific operating area income, and faith formation and sacramental preparation program income. All these categories of income had net increases compared to the prior year. The largest source of this income was \$63,000 from the sale of niches in our newly constructed Columbarium on the site of the Historic Church in Sykesville. It is a beautiful and peaceful resting place for our dearly departed loved ones.

Cost of utilities, property & liability insurance, and ordinary repairs and maintenance continue to increase yearly, as indicated by the 10% increase in Facilities Costs. No doubt you have experienced the same in your living expenses. Charitable distributions & specific operating area expenses were greater than last year (consistent with income), mostly due to the associated expenses for operating the Columbarium. Labor and Benefit expenses decreased in FY2024 due to various staff position vacancies.

Fiscal Year 2024 saw the continuation of Phase II of the Structural Reinforcement project to repair the south side columns in the Eldersburg Church. We raised an additional \$65,000 in pledges in FY2024, bringing the cumulative pledges for the combined Stained Glass & Structural Reinforcement project to \$746,700. Unfortunately, due to the extent of the damage to the columns throughout the church, this year's expense for the columns came to \$688,200, which brought the cumulative combined project costs to a total of \$1,495,000. The Stained Glass & Structural Reinforcement Project has an anticipated deficit of nearly \$600,000, which we withdrew from our reserve investments to cover. As of June 30, 2024 - the balance of unpaid pledges is \$98,000, and we greatly appreciate the efforts of our generous donors to honor those pledges before the end of calendar year 2024. Roof Replacement collections started in April 2024 and accumulated \$59,000 of the anticipated \$300,000 cost. The new roof will be installed and paid for in FY2025.

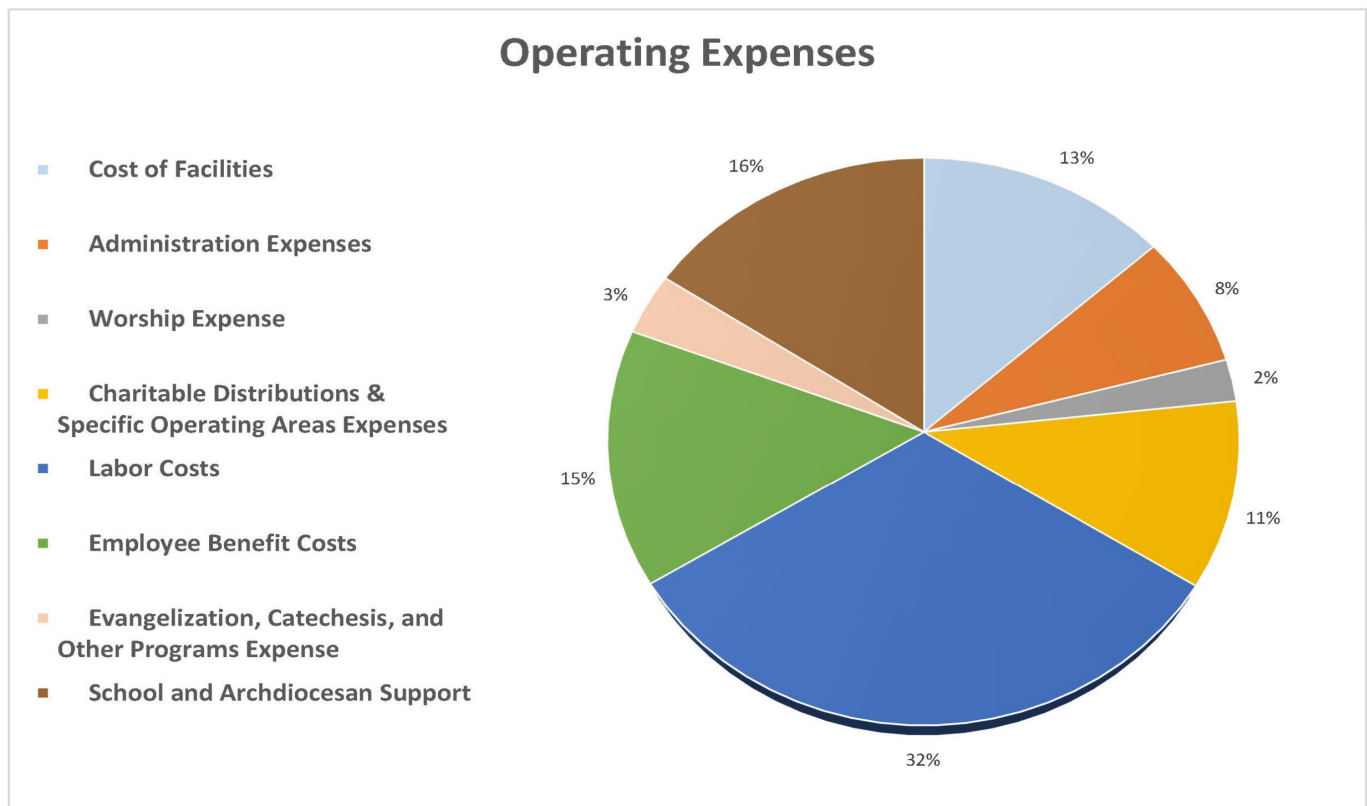
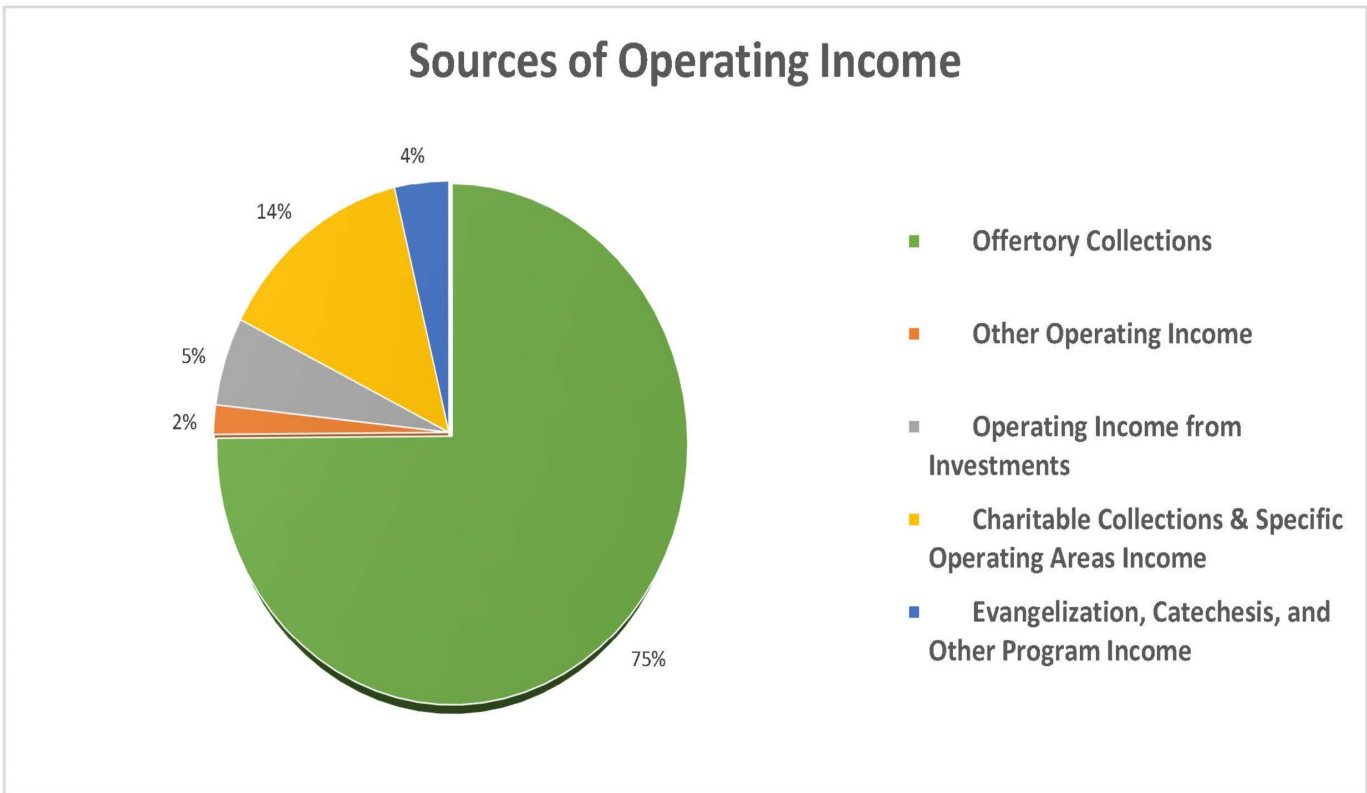
