Main Ideas

- Looking Back
 - Gen 12 Abrahamic Covenant Abram's encounter with God & God's promises to Abram
 - Where there is an encounter, there is a promise(s)
 - Where there is faith, there is a testing
 - Don't be surprised by the testing of your faith!
 - o Gen 15 ceremony of the Abrahamic Covenant
 - o Gen 17 Every covenant has signs
 - Circumcision is this sign
 - o Gen 22 ratification of the Covenant
- Fr. John walked us through a map of the ancient Promised Land and its surrounding area
 - Jericho and Sodom was only 13 miles apart
 - o AND DRASTICALLY DIFFERENT CLIMATE
 - o Jerusalem was a high mountainous region
 - o Jericho was deep under sea level, a city of palms with tropical climate
 - Sodom was A MASSIVE LAND
 - The most ancient, major city in the Middle Bronze Age
 - Indestructible
 - Massive economy
 - Trade throughout the Mediterranean
 - Guard towers etc
 - Sodom more famous discovered by a Christian archeologist as Tall el-Hammon "hill of the warm bath"
 - After Jerusalem, Sodom is the #2 most mentioned
- Lot is geting sucked into the world... into Sodom. He is losing himself to the most hedonistic and inhospitable city in the world
 - The sins in Sodom went beyond lust and sodomy, it was a brutal place where there was no sign of grace
- Key lessons learned don't look back to the sins of the past. Protect your family. Seek out the angels of the land, even in the midst of turmoil. When God says GO!, we go!
