From the Desk of Our Associate Pastor....

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Eucharistic sacrifice is the source and summit of the Christian life. Devotion to the Eucharist is an important way of deepening our love of Christ, and of drawing us to a deeper participation in the Paschal Mystery of His Passion, Death and Resurrection.



At SJCC, we endeavor to promote Eucharistic devotion in many ways, but especially by making available sufficient time and space for Eucharistic Exposition and adoration. Eucharistic Exposition is a public liturgical act, whereby the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in a monstrance or ciborium and either placed on an altar or carried in procession for adoration by the faithful. Please note that exposition and adoration are not the same thing. One may adore the Eucharist without the Eucharist being exposed.

As we continue to promote the practice of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at our parish, it's important that certain norms and guidelines be established that are consistent with the Church's liturgical praxis. (Many of these can be found in Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass, nos. 82-100.) To that end:

There should always be enough people present for Eucharistic adoration before the Blessed Sacrament exposed (HCWEMOM, 86, 88; Eucharisticum mysterium, 63; Codex Iuris Canonici, 942). Every effort should be made to ensure that there are at least two people present.

There must absolutely never be periods when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed, and no one is present for adoration (Redemptionis Sacramentum, 138). Therefore, it's necessary to expose the Blessed Sacrament for adoration only at stated times, and these are posted on the doors of the Chapel.

Exposition and reposition can happen a maximum of two times per calendar day (HCWEOM, 88). Therefore, the faithful are expressly forbidden to open the doors revealing the monstrance outside of designated times.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament solely for the purpose of giving the Benediction is prohibited (HCWEOM, 89).

If you do not regularly do so, please consider coming to adore the Eucharistic Lord. We spend time before the Blessed Sacrament, simply returning love for love; offering our thanksgiving to Jesus for who He is, for what He has done for us, for what He gives us. We pray that through adoration we may be changed, transformed, lit up. We pray that we may know Christ, and know we belong to Him. And we ask that we may have ever more abundantly the life He wants to give us; the life that is ours even now, and which endures forever.

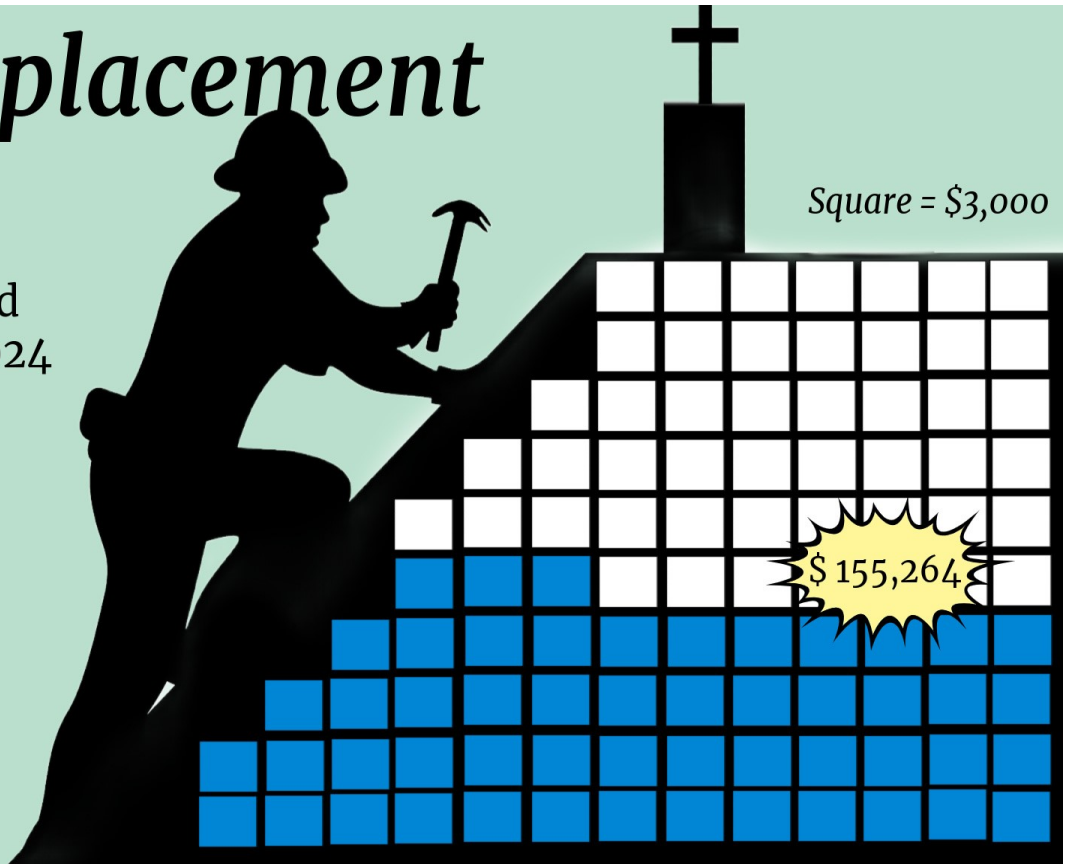
