From the Desk of Our Pastor...

Living the Scriptures

All four of our readings for this Sunday invite us to experience God and the spiritual realm through the eyes of others. We have the grand throne room vision of Isaiah, the beautiful refrain “In the sight of angels I will sing your praises, Lord” in our psalm, and St. Paul’s insistence that we hold fast the Gospel handed down to us through the Apostles, where Jesus appeared to them after the resurrection and later, to himself. Finally, we have in the Gospel reading the fishing experience the disciples had with Jesus in their boat.



To read these Scriptures the way they were intended to be read, we must do so with faith and a holy imagination; faith in believing that these narratives describe true realities and holy imagination in that we are invited to experience them as if we were there with the prophet and the apostles. They mean nothing to us if we read them only as stories or mere religious sentiments. In fact, Isaiah’s vision forms the very heart of our Mass; the awe of coming before the throne of the King of the Universe, the Sanctus, humility of repentance and the cleansing from our sins, and then the sending, or commission to change the world around us. We live out this vision at every Mass. This is all done before very sight of angles who both witness and participate in our common worship.

None of us have seen the risen Lord, at least in the way that the Apostles did. But this simply doesn’t matter in light of those words of our Lord to Thomas, “blessed are those who have not seen but believed” (John 20:29). It is important to St. Paul that the disciples did see, and that we see the risen Lord by faith and holy imagination through their testimony. Jesus is just as real to us as He was to His own disciples through the Holy Spirit who brings Holy Scriptures alive to us.

Finally, we have that scene in the boat where St. Peter came to self-knowledge and the knowledge of who Jesus was by the miracle of the fishes. To read this story they were intended to be read, we must see ourselves in the boat in awe and amazement. We then realize that Jesus right now is in our boats doing daily miracles for us in His divine providence. This is how we should all live by living the Scriptures.



Our History

The WSJF story began in the summer of 2013 with a small ministry team that met to determine if Saint Joseph Catholic Community (SJCC) should apply for an FCC permit to construct a low-power FM radio station. The team made application in November 2014, and was awarded an FCC construction permit in June of 2015. At the end of 2016, we requested an FCC permit extension until June 12, 2018. The Radio Ministry team raised money, made convincing arguments to the SJCC Pastoral Council, and produced necessary plans and documents during 2016 and 2017. The team acquired the necessary hardware in March and April 2018.

We placed our antenna on a tower in Sykesville in mid-May 2018. In a live broadcast on June 3, 2018, our SJCC pastor blessed WSJF and the studio, and that week WSJF-LP began broadcasting 24/7/365. WSJF is one of two parish-based Catholic radio stations in the Archdiocese of Baltimore.

WSJF offers home-grown programs which are developed here at SJCC, including:

Deep Dive into Scripture, Family Rosary across the Parish, First Saturday Devotions, Friday Night is Music Night, Knights around the Table, our Sunday 10:45 am Mass, Music for the Masses, The WSJF Music Hour, Spirit of Sainthood, Reflections of a Humble Scribe, Top Tunes Weekly and more



Our Team

The team supports the station by ensuring its broadcast quality; writing, recording, and producing "spots" for broadcast; and developing and producing original shows.

All of the support work happens in the WSJF broadcast and recording studio in the lower level of the SJCC Parish Center.
