From the Desk of Our Pastor...

Being a Good Fruit Tree

One of my fondest memories is of an old cherry tree behind a property my father once owned. What a joy for a 4 or 5-year-old kid to climb up its branches, grab a handful of cherries, and gobble them up. To this day, I am very partial to cherry pies! Think of a world destitute of fruit trees. What would life be like? Fruit is nature's dessert! But more than that, fruit is critical to our diet.

We do not know what sort of fruit tree the Tree of Life was, nor for that matter, the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil is usually depicted as an apple tree for some reason. Be this as it may, fruit trees are a significant motif in Scripture, one that is used to describe who we are and should be. We find this in our readings for this week. In Sirach, we see "The fruit of the tree shows the care it has had," and Jesus teaches, "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit," and "Every tree is known by its fruit." We have a purpose: to be a good fruit tree like Jesus is, a tree of life for all.

There are two practical ways for us to engage this metaphor in our lives this Lent. First of all, our "Life Mapping" program is where we explore our lives and create our own spiritual biography. Key to bearing fruit is self-knowledge, and knowing who and what has influenced us along the way, seeing God in all things, even the bad, coming to repentance, and recognizing with joy God's faithfulness and grace, the spiritual fruits of the Spirit. With this knowledge, we can become more intentional about being a tree that yields supernatural fruit. We began on Saturday morning, but you can start any time, SaintJoseph.cc/Lenten-Reflection.

Another opportunity is our "Walk with One" initiative. We began this back in September, we encouraged all of us to pray for an individual who needs God and His Church. This month, we would like to take the next step of actually engaging with this person, to accompany him or her as a genuine friend, inviting them into your life, and enjoying your "fruit," so to speak. Again, see the website for details.

There is a joy of producing fruit supernaturally, fruit that we could never produce on our own, freely offering to others, that I most sincerely hope we all experience this Lenten season.

SJCC is happy to support Catholic education. We offer tuition assistance to our parishioners whose children attend Archdiocesan elementary schools.





Walk with One Initiative

There is someone in your life right now who Jesus longs to call to Himself. He wants to spark a relationship with them and bless them with his sacraments.

Mission

Catholics across the U.S. are saying “yes” to a special form of heart-to-heart accompaniment called the **Walk With One** initiative.

Through **Walk with One**, we hope to develop a Eucharistic culture within our community, where we each see ourselves being taken by the Holy Spirit, broken, and poured out to meet the needs of another person and to bring them into the fullness of life in Christ.

Go Deeper



March – Connect in Eucharistic Friendship

Look for ways to accompany the person you have prayed for, to build a deeper relationship, and to practice the art of empathetic listening. Receive what the other person has to share, lift it up in prayer, let the Holy Spirit break open an area for potential growth, and then give of yourself in response. Develop a real friendship and get to know your friend's joys and struggles. Listen respectfully when the conversation turns to spiritual matters, including their relationship with God and questions or concerns about the Church, and reserve judgment about their opinions.



Overview

Step 1 – Identify

- Pray to discern the name of someone the Holy Spirit wants you to walk with. Ask God who He wants you to accompany on their journey home to the Church.

Step 2 – Intercede

- Pray for the person. Ask God to remove whatever obstacles are making it difficult for this person to draw closer to Christ and His Church.

Step 3 – Connect

- Look for ways to build a deeper relationship with this person. Listen deeply for promptings from the Holy Spirit as you get to know your friend's joys and struggles.

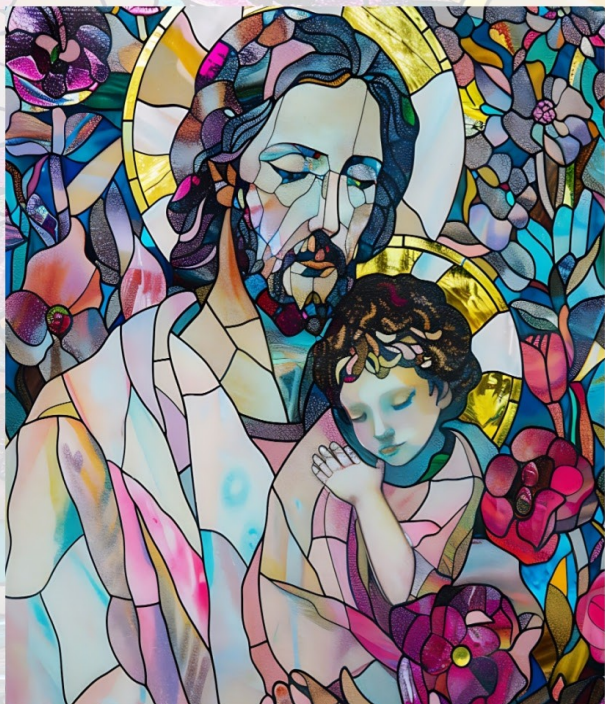
Step 4 – Invite

- When the time is right, invite your friend to take a concrete next step in fostering a personal relationship with Jesus and the Church. This might mean joining you for a small group, adoration, or Mass on Sunday.
