## From the Desk of Our Clergy ...

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Archdiocese of Baltimore has recently moved to lower the normative age of Confirmation to nine years. This provides us with an opportunity to learn more about the least understood Sacrament of Initiation. From now until Pentecost, some of these bulletin letters will be dedicated to exploring the richness of this sacrament. Today, let's begin with the testimony of Scripture.

Admittedly, the Scriptural foundation for the Sacrament of Confirmation is somewhat obscure. On one hand, Christ promised the gift of the Holy Spirit; on the other hand, Scripture doesn't explicitly testify to Christ's institution of the Sacrament of Confirmation—at least not as explicitly as the institution of the other Sacraments of Initiation. Christ clearly commanded the Eleven: “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19-20). Christ instituted and commanded the Eucharist to be celebrated in perpetuity: “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me” (Lk 22:19; Mt 26:26; Mk 14:22; 1 Cor 11:23-25).

Since there is no narrative in the Gospels where Christ confirmed others or commands His disciples to be confirmed, “nothing is certain about the precise moment in which the Lord instituted Confirmation” (Paul Haffner, *The Sacramental Mystery*, 62). There is, however, Jesus' warning to His disciples that they would stand trial and that the Holy Spirit would come upon them and inspire their answers (Mt 10:19-20; Mk 13:11; Lk 12:11-12). There are also the words of Christ to Nicodemus and the Samaritan woman about being born again of “water and spirit” and worshipping the Father “in spirit and truth” (John 3:1-7, 4:23). At the festival of booths, there is His offer: “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, and let the one who believes in me drink. As the Scripture has said, ‘Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water.’ Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive...” (Jn 7:37-39). On the first Maundy Thursday, there is Christ's promise to His disciples: “I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, to be with you forever” (Jn 14:16). When Christ appeared to His disciples in Jerusalem after the Resurrection, He said to them, “I am sending upon you what my Father promised...” (Lk 24:49) Before His Ascension, there is Christ's instruction for the Apostles to wait for “the promise of the Father” because “you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you” (Acts 1:4, 8). The fulfillment of this promise occurs at Pentecost.

The New Testament attests to the descent of the Holy Spirit, as well as people being filled with the Holy Spirit, several times: The “the Holy Spirit descended upon [Jesus] in bodily form like a dove” at His Baptism in the River Jordan (Lk 3:22. Cf. Mt 3:16, Isa 11:2, Jn 1:33). The Holy Spirit “rested on” Simeon, a “righteous and devout” man (Lk 2:25). It was prophesied before the birth of John the Baptist that “even before his birth he will be filled with the Holy Spirit” (Lk 1:15). Zechariah, Jesus, Peter, and Stephen the Protomartyr are considered *full of* or *filled with* the Holy Spirit (Lk 1:67, 4:1; Acts 4:8, 31, 6:5).

The Acts of the Apostles is replete with references to the Holy Spirit and His work in the Church. Obviously, the Holy Spirit was given by Christ first to His Apostles before the descent of the Holy Spirit on the other disciples at Pentecost. Scripture affirms the ability of people to receive the Holy Spirit in fulfillment of God’s promise to renew creation. After the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, it seems that a new, post-baptismal rite has been instituted.

Following the teaching of Christ, Peter told those around him, “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit” (Acts 2:38). From this sentence alone, it’s unclear if the Sacrament of Baptism imparts the gift of the Holy Spirit, or if Peter is looking ahead to a new sacred action to be performed by those with Apostolic authority. Another passage from the Acts of the Apostles provides clarity:

*Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them. The two went down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit (for as yet the Spirit had not come upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus). Then Peter and John laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit. (Acts 8:14-17)*

Based on this passage, it seems that Baptism did not bestow the gift of the Spirit on believers—only the imposition of hands by Apostles did that. Throughout Acts, the imposition of hands is linked with the imparting of the Holy Spirit (Acts 8:17-20, 9:17, 13:2-4). While in Ephesus, the Apostle Paul encountered some ‘disciples,’ though they had been baptized only with John’s baptism and had no knowledge of the Holy Spirit. So Paul baptized them “in the name of the Lord Jesus” and subsequently “laid his hands on them ... [so that] the Holy Spirit came upon them...” (Acts 19:1-6. Cf. 1 Tim 4:14; 2 Tim 1:6).

Next week, we’ll look at the practice of the early Church as we explore the organic development of the sacrament of Confirmation.

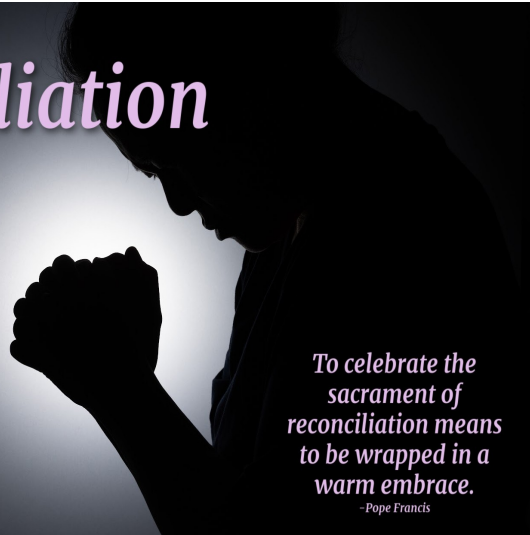

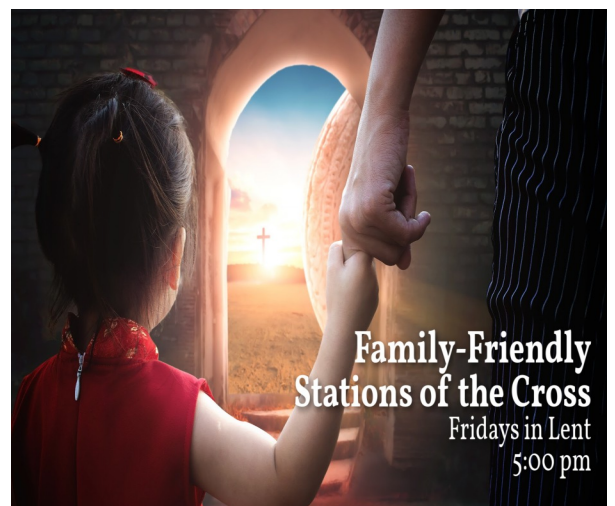
