From the Desk of Our Clergy ...

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today we turn back to the Sacrament of Confirmation. We've looked at the testimony of Scripture and the practice of the early Church; this week, we continue our historical survey.

In the mid-19th century, local or regional gatherings of bishops in France called for First Communion to be given before Confirmation; this had never been done before. The Council of Tours (1849) required "that no one may admitted to [Confirmation] until he comes to first communion, unless of course a grave reason argues otherwise in the judgment of the bishop." In the same year, the Council of Avignon recognized the universal norm that Confirmation was to be celebrated at the age of reason but stated, "in the province of Avignon, this sacrament may not be administered to children until after their first communion." Soon after, the Councils of Sens (1850), Rouen (1850), and Auch (1851) issued similar pronouncements.

According to the Fifth Council of Prague (1860), "Children who have obtained the use of reason ... should not easily be brought to the mysteries of holy chrism without reasonable cause before they have been admitted to first communion." The usual reason given for postponing Confirmation until after First Communion was that more time was available for religious education.

When the Sacred Congregation of the Council in Rome became aware of the French bishops' deviation from the traditional order of the Sacraments of Initiation, the Sacred Congregation responded with a call to restore the proper order:

Since for a long time a lower age has been required for admittance to the sacrament of confirmation than for admittance to First Communion ... it is proposed to you that the doctrine reported (article 22, p. 19 in the Synodal Acts) be reformed accordingly, so that the first place may be for conferring confirmation, and then, at an opportune time, for supplying First Communion.

Just five years after the historical sacramental order was disrupted, Rome responded by calling for a return to the order that had previously been observed.

In the late 19th century, Bishop Joseph-Jean-Louis Robert of Marseilles wrote to Pope Leo XIII for his opinion regarding his intention to administer Confirmation to the faithful before First Communion. Recognizing Robert's desire to "to restore in the practice of [his] diocese a custom which has been almost universally repealed,



namely that of children receiving the sacrament of Confirmation, by anointing with the blessed chrism, before they are fed at the divine banquet of the Eucharist,” Pope Leo XIII responded on 22 June 1897:

The manner of thinking which has grown up in your own diocese and elsewhere is in keeping neither with the ancient and constant practice of the Church nor with the best interests of the faithful. For there exist in the souls of children the seeds of desires which, unless they are removed in timely fashion, gradually grow in strength, lead the inexperienced astray, and send them headlong into sin. For this reason, the faithful need to be clothed with power from on high from their earliest years, and it was to convey such power that the sacrament of Confirmation was born. In Confirmation ... the Holy Spirit is given as strength for spiritual combat and the human person is brought to spiritual maturity. Indeed, young people who are confirmed are rendered more susceptible to observing the commandments, and more prepared for receiving afterwards the Eucharist, and are able to draw greater benefits from what they receive. For which reasons it is our desire that the provisions you have so wisely restored should be faithfully observed in perpetuity.

Clearly, Pope Leo XIII wished to restore the proper order of the Sacraments of Initiation in those places where it had become disordered. Next week, we'll consider the impact of lowering of the age of First Communion in the Roman Church before looking at the restoration of the Sacraments of Initiation following the Second Vatican Council.



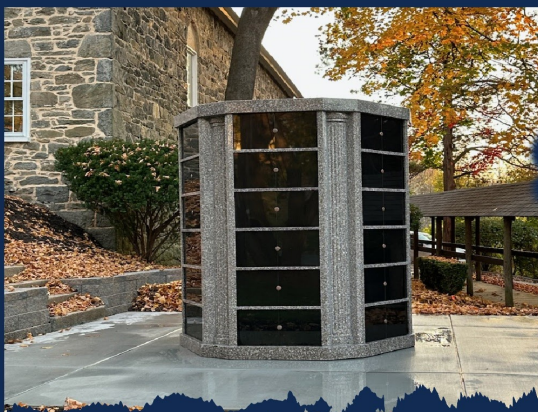

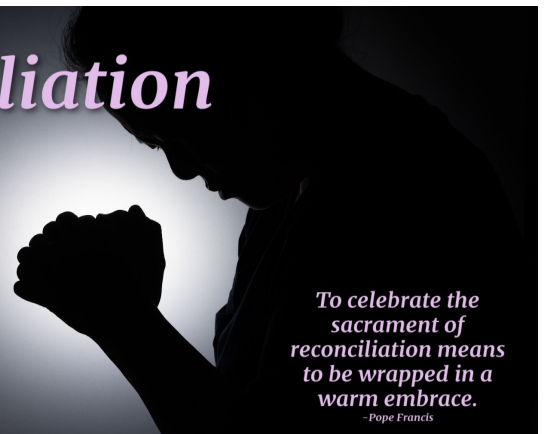
