## From the Desk of Our Associate Pastor ...

Dear Friends in Christ,

As He was ascending to the glory of the Father, Jesus said, “Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age” (Mt 28:20). And He also taught us: “Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you” (John 6:53). He fulfills both promises by remaining with His Church and giving Himself to us in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.



Christ keeps His promise to be with us always in another way: in the person and ministry of His priests. I hope that I have been both a sign and source of God’s presence among you during my time here. The announcement of my reassignment and coming departure was abrupt and has left little time for me to plan, pack, and say goodbye to you all. For that, I’m very sorry.

My thoughts are still scattered, so here’s what is most important to say:

There is no distance in the Eucharist. God continues to unite us through the celebration of the Mass, for we all participate in the one Mass that is celebrated in Heaven for all eternity. I pray that you continue to grow in faith, so that Jesus in the Eucharist will truly be the source and summit of your lives.

Be good to Fr Andrew. He’s a good man and a great priest. Just as I hope to be received well in future assignments, I want you all to welcome and get to know Fr Andrew.

Farewells are sad affairs, but as I prepare to take on new responsibilities at a new mission church, I trust that the Lord will continue to set His Heart on us and give us life. Please, point others to Him, with confidence and joy.

Lastly, please be faithful in your Sunday Mass attendance, for in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar we behold the same Christ now worshiped in glory by the Angels and Saints: Come, let us adore Him!
