From the Desk of Our Pastor ...

The Paradox of Clarity and Mystery

Our Sunday readings invite us into a paradox. A “paradox” depicts two things that seem totally opposite and contrary, but are nevertheless true. The paradox is that our Catholic faith is both crystal clear and yet lofty, deep, mysterious, and impossible to comprehend fully.

In our Deuteronomy passage, Moses tells the Israelites they do not have to be rocket scientists to understand what God expects from them; His commandments are not remote in the sky above! Nor do they have to navigate across the wide expanse of the seas. No! God’s expectations as delivered to the people by divine revelation, that is, His law, are very near to them, indeed, in their very mouths and hearts. They were a culture of memorizers; they could recite the laws by heart! As the Psalm tells us, the laws are more precious than gold to the humble heart. They just need to carry it out. Not only this, but we Catholics know about natural revelation; God has placed into every human heart a general knowledge of what is right and wrong; all we need to do is to participate in what we all know to be true.

This clarity is fundamental to everything, the way we live, and the way we pass through the regions of this world to the judgment seat of Christ. At the judgment, there will be no arguing at all, just a crystal clear knowledge and acceptance of what is true about ourselves in light of God’s truth. There will be no trial, no jury, no ambiguity - just those penetrating divine eyes and a just judgement!

On the other hand, our faith is a great, unfathomable mystery. At the root of this is the incarnation - Jesus, God in the flesh! In our Colossians passage, we are confronted with the sheer magnitude of Jesus. How can such immense power we see in all of creation be contained in one Person? How can Jesus be the center where all “fullness” is pleased to dwell? He is the Son of God existing before all time, Incarnate God Son of Mary in time, the Ascended Christ above all time, the cosmic Christ that holds everything together, the Eucharistic Christ distributed to all the faithful in every time, and dwelling within the hearts of believers all the time!

Thank God for clarity! Thank God for mystery that will take eternity to explore!
P.S we will not quiz you on this Christology after Mass this week!

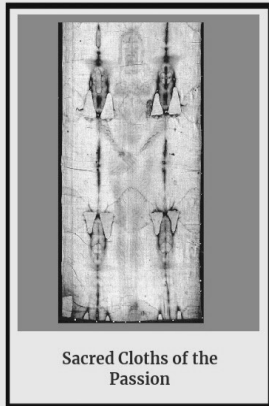

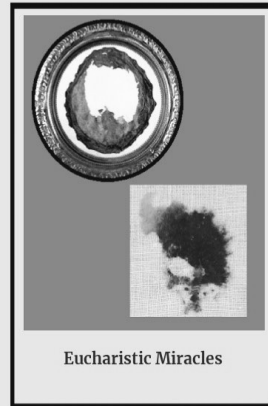

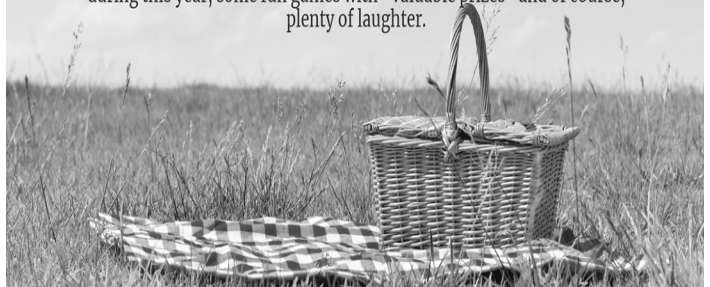
