## From the Desk of Our Pastor ...

### Investing Wisely

We have all heard about or know of people who are investors. I have even seen them on the beach sitting in their fold-out chairs, Wall Street Journal in hand, totally absorbed in the stock market. Personally, I could use a little more of this in my own life, for investing seems to be a wise thing to do, even if one has limited means. But what is infinitely more important is the investment we make in eternal things rather than temporal things. Jesus Himself seems fascinated with money and investments given the number of parables where He employs financial imagery to make His point. It is a fundamental biblical fact that we are all given time, treasure, and talent, and everything turns on how we invest.



Our readings for Sunday reinforce this truth. In Ecclesiastes we find that we all, as fallen creatures in a fallen world, are subject to “vanity.” This word in Hebrew would not indicate “valueless,” or “worthless,” or even “empty.” The conundrum is that the things of this world do have value because God created everything good. However, because of God’s curse on the ground in judgement for sin, nothing brings the satisfaction one expects from these good things. Case in point, the more money one has should bring a corresponding happiness, but it does not, and can bring an even greater unhappiness. Even wisdom itself, as good as it is, and as necessary as it is, does not deliver what we expect, for the wiser we are, the more sorrow we experience from all the absurdities of this world. Just ask Jesus who is Wisdom Incarnate!

This brings us to our Colossians reading. Since we have the marvelous advantage of being raised with Christ, we must not revert our energies to earthly transient things, but invest in what exists above all the temporal things that might entice us here below. Especially, we must put to death all the vices that lock us into the temporal, like concupiscence of lust, envy, and greed. We find an example of this in the Gospel where someone comes to Jesus all bent out of shape over his inheritance. Jesus gives him, and us, a parable warning us of greed and the amassing of riches in this world.

The moral for us at SJCC is clear. God has given us a vision for our parish, and we need all on board to be good investors. We need your generous time, talent, and treasure to accomplish this vision.
