# Okay, what are the new Sacramental Prep hurdles in 2025-2026?

Each year, the famous question in Sacramental Preparation for 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist, and Confirmation is **“What do I have to do to get these sacraments?”** The question asked is inherently not a bad question. It is requesting the roadmap for a journey to reach a goal. “I know I’m here, and I want to get there, so what’s the plan?” What makes one ready for these sacraments listed above? What is sacramental readiness? When do I reach *the goal*?

Fr. Patrick McCain, before he was reassigned to Texas this summer, gave an incredible series of letters in the bulletins that explained how Confirmation was celebrated in the Church’s history. While I encourage you to check out those letters in April-May, I wish to borrow one key point from them – by Baptism, we are made ready to receive 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, Confirmation, and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist. When we are adopted into the Family of God at Baptism, God is already calling us into full initiation into the Catholic Church- to receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation and His Son Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

Instead of asking “What do I do?”, I encourage us all to ask, **“Who am I to become?”** Attending classes, completing at-home work, and attending Family Faith Formation meals are wonderful, but I want to urge everyone this year to say, “I want to have a deeper relationship with God this year. How can I love Him more deeply? I want to know God more!”

Now, we can launch into specifics.

## **So, what do I have to do?**

To build on the topic of **formation** (our word for teaching or catechesis, which is specific education and practice of our Catholic Faith in a parish setting from trained ministry leaders and volunteers so that we can live our faith daily), we’re asking all candidates for 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist, and Confirmation between ages 7-18, to register for Family Faith Formation first. These meals are critical to the year because they will offer both parent and candidate formation. Of the 12 meals offered from September to April, Sacramental Prep families must attend a minimum of 6.

For candidates ages 7-11 (elementary school) who will receive any of the three sacraments, you will attend a minimum of 6 of the 12 FFF with your families, complete at-home work with textbooks with your parents (Saint Joseph will purchase textbooks after registration). There will be workshops in Spring 2026 to practice receiving Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist, and later for Confirmation.

For candidates ages 9-14 (3<sup>rd</sup> –8<sup>th</sup> Grade) who will primarily receive Confirmation, you will attend 6 of the 12 FFF with your families, and complete at-home work with a textbook. You will be encouraged to participate in their age-specific youth group called ROOTED or EDGE, which will reinforce a sacramental overview in a dynamic environment.

For candidates ages 14-18 (high school), to receive any sacrament, you will be required to attend 6 of the 12 FFF with your families, attend twice a month Tuesday Sacrament classes from September to April, and have at-home work with videos and a textbook. The high schoolers will also participate in Mount 2000 at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg, February 6-8, 2026. High Schoolers are encouraged to attend LifeTeen on Sundays.

All sacramental celebrations will take place in Spring 2026 (March-May).

**The goal is still to attend all these classes and work from at-home. What about the relationship with God?**

Attendance, the at-home work, and the retreat/workshops are all opportunities to foster a relationship with God by having encounters with Him. At Saint Joseph, almost all of our classes end in the main church or chapel, where we visit Jesus Christ. Every year, candidates encounter God in a powerful way, and this year, we ask you to join us in the Pilgrimage of Hope for all our candidates and their families to fall in love with God and the Catholic Church.


