From the Desk of Our Pastor ...

Parish Pastoral Plan

Many of us here at Saint Joseph Catholic Church have a sense that the Holy Spirit is at work among us in new and exciting ways. We are rallying around our new vision statement: "Saint Joseph Catholic Church will be the spiritual, moral, and social heart of Eldersburg/Sykesville through encounters with Jesus Christ." Our path to this vision is our mission statement: "We encounter God through celebrating the sacraments, proclaiming the Gospel, and reflecting God's love through service."



It is our encounters with God that make everything real and authentic in our lives and worship. There are six mission priorities that fill our parish pastoral plan as we work through our mission to our vision. These are not something we dreamed up on our own, but priorities given to us by our Archbishop Lori in his two pastoral letters, "A Light Brightly Visible 1.0" (2016) and 2nd edition (2021). We do not operate here as an independent entity; everything we do here is in keeping with the Archdiocese and the Catholic Church at large. These priorities are:

- ♥ Encounter: The Holy Trinity is intrinsically relational and is always seeking relationship. We must be sensitive relationally both towards God and one another, open to divine encounters of every kind.
- ♥ Welcoming: Those who encounter God are welcoming to others, creating a holy place where people naturally feel at home, like they belong.
- ♥ Accompaniment: Everyone must be formed into the likeness and image of Jesus Christ our Lord. This demands that we all are being formed and are forming others, leading people, like Andrew, to Jesus.
- ♥ Liturgy: It is especially at Mass where we encounter God through Jesus Christ, who is both our High Priest and Sacrifice, by the power of the Holy Spirit. Our worship must inspire both joy and awe.
- ♥ Sending: Our word "Mass" comes from the Latin, "sent out." If we are well formed in Christ and fortified by our Mass, we will naturally be that light brightly visible to all those we interact with outside the walls of our church.
- ♥ Mission Support: All the priorities above depend upon everyone to give of their time, treasure, and talents. We will cultivate an environment of stewardship.

Over the next six weeks we will focus on one of these priorities in our communications and Masses.

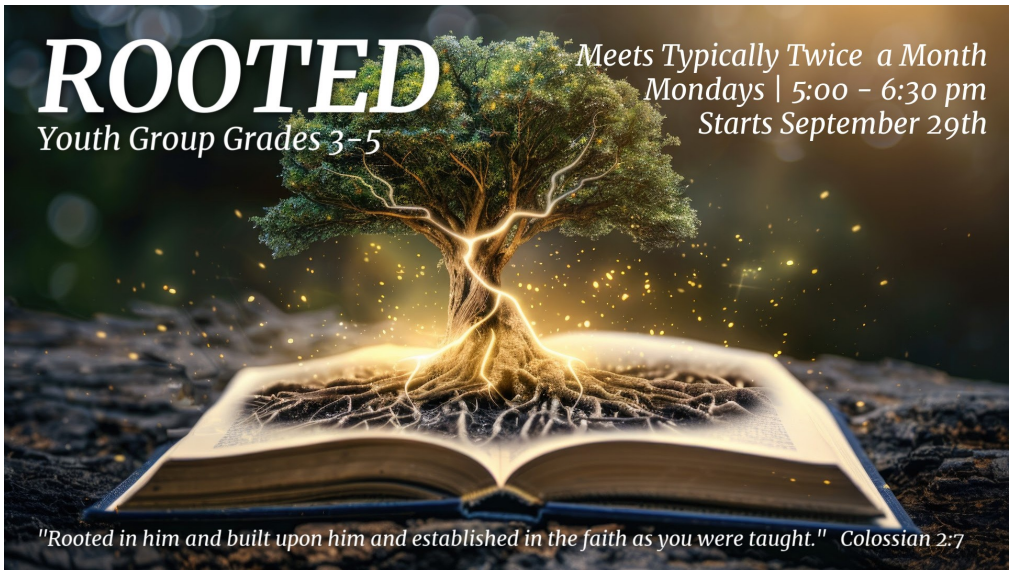

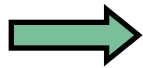
