## From the Desk of Our Pastor ...

### Mission Priority: Liturgy

There is nothing remotely like the Mass on earth. It is unique, timeless, holy. Essentially, the liturgy of the Mass is worship acted out, a divine and human drama of sacrifice. The processional, the reverencing of the altar, the opening prayer that “collects” minds together toward God, the liturgy of the Word with Old Testament and New Testament readings, the sung Psalm in between, the Gospel reading and the proclamation of the Word by the priest or deacon, the communal recitation of the creed and the prayers of the faithful, all flow together in anticipation of the liturgy of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is that sacred moment of sacrifice, where we are transported back in time to Christ’s sacrifice offered once for all, and forward to the heavenly banquet with all the angels and saints in glory.



What is happening is something real, truly awe-inspiring, and extremely costly. There is no such thing as worship without sacrifice. The request of Prayer III, “May He make of us an eternal offering unto you...” should make us all pause and think deeply about what we are doing in the Mass. As Christ offered Himself to us, we are to offer ourselves up to God and our fellow parishioners, willing to live and die for Christ and one another. This is exactly what Jesus is telling us in His unsettling teaching in the Gospel for this week. We must not let even family get in the way of the radical lifestyle we are called to. We must take up our cross, count the cost, and renounce all earthly things that would get in the way.

This holy liturgy must be, in all its parts, music, actions, atmosphere, and attitudes, congruent with its awesome meaning. This means that it cannot be reduced to something common, readily accessible to someone from the outside to understand. The Mass is, by its nature, full of goodness, beauty, and truth, and we at Saint Joseph Catholic Church must strive to live into it deeply with all our love to make it even more so. I met a woman who had just walked into our Mass, totally ignorant of what was going on, and said, “How come nobody ever told me about this?” She sensed the holiness of the moment, even though she didn’t understand.

Though the Mass isn’t “evangelistic” as an easy entryway into our Catholic faith, it speaks for itself to an open soul if done most authentically. This is what we are striving for in our liturgy, and it is fundamental as one of our mission priorities.

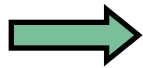

We are now using OnlineGiving as our new electronic giving platform. It differs from our previous provider, Faith Direct, in several ways. Keep reading to find out how...

**Important & Helpful Hints** for setting up your gifts in OnlineGiving:

- Your account is established with just your **email address and cell phone number** - a password is not necessary
- If giving to multiple funds, you must set up one at a time
- If you choose the frequency of 'weekly' - funds will be taken from your account once a week (52 times per year). If you want to give a weekly amount and have it taken from your account once a month, take your weekly amount x 52 /12 to arrive at your monthly gift. For example, if you want to give \$30 per week -  $30 \times 52 = \$1,560$  per year  $\div 12$  months = \$130 per month.
- Special & Second Collections is a separate giving page which can be found by clicking the menu option on the top right-hand side of the page. All of these collections are **annual collections**. When you click on Recurring, choose "Yearly" for the frequency. Then, **PLEASE choose a day in the month that the collection is for**. For example: the collection named "Christmas (December)" is a collection in the month of December. PLEASE pick a date in the month of December. If you select Recurring, this gift will be processed on the same day in December every year.
