Opening Prayer

Fr. John stated the roll out of the new Vision and Mission statements will begin the weekend of Pentecost, June 8th.

A marketing piece/flyer to accompany the roll out was presented for feedback. Discussion included ideas to adjust the layout of information and color to clarify the message and symbolism. Additional suggestions to improve the efficacy of the flyer are to be sent to Fr. John.

Ministry Assessments

Items to consider: How, when, who, repercussions

Assessment Tool: Encountering Christ through the Parish (provided by AoB)

Review and discussion of the assessment tool resulted in the following:

- Fr. John will create a Pastor-gram on the topic of Encounter. Encounters with Christ is the core of our mission. The pastor-gram will be viewed at the start of each ministry assessment meeting
- Assessments should be conducted IN PERSON with at least 2 members of the PPC and the leader of each ministry
- The Assessment tool will feature one ministry per sheet as opposed to the original format of several ministries per sheet
- Specific questions about how each ministry supports the mission statement and brings about the vision of the Parish will be added
- Questions will be added to collect updated information about contact information/leadership/member list/structure/content of curriculum if applicable
- Question will be added to identify how the ministry supports participants on their spiritual journey (discipleship pathway); Each person is at a different point in their journey, participation in ministries should allow for formation opportunities
- Discuss with ministry leaders the idea of injecting what they are already doing with intentionality. Discuss the use of prayer throughout the work of the ministry to inspire creativity. Help ministry leaders understand how their ministry connects to the big picture of service and the mission of the parish.

- Question added to identify resources needed by the ministry to operate, and ascertain future goals (may include mentoring someone for future leadership of ministry)
- Remove *Value of Investment* question, and replace with questions about perceived impact, and the effort to outcome ratio.
- End with question soliciting the leader's opinion about the ministries offered and ministries that may be needed to help identify gaps and redundancies.

The list of ministries will be sent via email to PPC members. Members will indicate which ministries would like to assess. The remaining ministries will be divided among the members. Assessments are to begin following the next PPC meeting.

At the next meeting on May 7th, the PPC will review the revised assessment tool, and the completed pastor-gram on *Encounter*. The assignments of ministries to PPC members for assessment will be finalized.
